





  - Nitrogen Pollution as a Policy Challenge:
  - Study how nitrogen-based fertilizers and industrial emissions contribute to environmental degradation (e.g., eutrophication, greenhouse gases).
  - Analyze international agreements like the Paris Agreement or UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) that address nitrogen management.
  - Case Study: The European Union's Nitrogen Policy and its role in shaping regional environmental regulations.
- Political Ecology:
  - Examine power imbalances in nitrogen use:
  - o Wealthy nations vs. developing countries in fertilizer consumption.
  - Corporate control of agrochemical industries (e.g., Bayer-Monsanto's influence on farming policies).
- Agriculture & Food Security
  - o Geopolitics of Fertilizers:
  - Nitrogen fertilizers are critical for food production. Study how access to fertilizers shapes food security and political stability.
  - o Example: India's fertilizer subsidy policies and their socio-political impact on farmers.

Air Quality & Mental Health:
